

On April 23, 2022 the Outreach team held a family Fun Event at the Boonsboro City Park. Again, New Beginnings Church body stepped up with donating food items, items for the auction, cake walk, animal walk and yard sale along with their time and many hours of loving labor. We were able to present a check to Care Net of \$1,670.50. As of this printing we have been Blessed to raise \$2,827.88 in 2022 to help this very necessary and worthwhile organization.

Finance team mid-year budget update:

The church financials are looking good! Six months into the year and we are right on budget on income and below budget on expenses. We have reached 50% of our offerings budget so far for the year and we have only used 36% of our budgeted expenses! Great job to all of the chairs for saving where they can!

Tammy will be handing out the budget worksheets to the chairs so they can begin working on the 2023 budget. The budget worksheets are due back to finance no later than July 17. The finance team will meet in late July/early August to begin discussing the 2023 budget. We will be presenting the 2023 budget to the Leadership team in September.

Pastor Karen's Wednesday thoughts 4/20/2022 Isaiah 41:10 So do not fear, for I Am with you; do not be dismayed, for I Am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.

I am sure all of us have been afraid at one time or another in our lives. In the world we live in there are many things to be afraid of. Every time we get in the car, walk in a restaurant, board a plane, attend a concert we take the chance of something happening to us or those we love. Just turning on the TV can strike us with great fear as we watch gas prices rise, shortages on the grocery store shelves, our children being taught to question even their own identity, abortion clinics thriving, lockdowns in other countries where you hear screaming from high rise complexes of people wanting to get out!!

Fear can grip us and in these last two years it certainly has. Remember the shut down for Covid was only to last two weeks? And two years later we are still dealing with residue of fear. Fear is a powerful tool of satan. He uses it against us time and time again. He uses it to keep us quiet, he uses it to control us, he uses it to divide us and he uses it to cause us to lose our hope and trust in our Lord.

In Isaiah the Lord tells us not to fear, for He is with us!! We are not to be dismayed or hopeless for He is our God!! He will strengthen us and help us!! He will uphold us with His righteous right hand!! We can read this scripture over and over again but until we believe it deep down inside of ourselves it will not make any difference!

King David tells us in Psalm 27 that the Lord is his light and his salvation...is He yours? David asks, "Whom shall I fear?" Who do we fear?? He says, "the Lord is the stronghold of His life"!! Do we believe that our Lord is strong enough to keep us from harm? Do we believe He can carry us through the hard times? David asks, "of whom shall I be afraid"?? What and whom are we afraid of?? He also says "when evil men advance against me to devour my flesh, when my enemies and my foes attack me, they will stumble and fall"! Do we believe that our God is so strong and so powerful that when the enemy attacks with lies, with heartache, with fear, with hopelessness that He can deliver us from the evil one?? That our enemies WILL STUMBLE AND FALL?

There are so many scriptures in God's Word about fear. Three hundred and sixty-five times we are told to "FEAR NOT!" One for each day of the year!! Apparently, our Lord knew we would need to be reminded every day not to fear.

Joshua 1:9. The Lord commanded Joshua, to be strong and courageous. To not be afraid; to not be discouraged, FOR THE LORD YOUR GOD WILL BE WITH YOU WHEREVER YOU GO!!

This is what I want you to remember!! The Lord is with you!! He will strengthen you!! He will give you courage when you need it!! He will uphold you with His righteous and mighty right hand!! There is no devil in Hell that can stand against the POWERFUL WORD OF GOD!!
