Fellowship Team by Judy Abel The fellowship team arranged a wonderful potluck lunch in July at the church and also after the baptism service in August, and were instrumental in arranging the Prayer On The Hill night in September with ice cream provided by Christ's Cream. What an amazing night of worship that was. We have a wonderful team who work together, along with the congregation, to assure our fellowship events are well planned and executed while lifting God's name on high. Thanks to all our team members and the congregation for your support and help.

Board of Trustees, Eddie Moser—Chair: The Trustees encourage you to continue in prayer about God's provision and particularly for His guidance concerning our own church facility. We have formulated and have preliminary approval for a new Lease Agreement with our Seventh Day Adventist brothers and sisters and we are so fortunate to have such a nice facility in which to worship. May God continue to richly bless this arrangement.

Financial Management Team, by Tammy Fisher Budget update through September 30, 2023: We have reached 82% of our general offering budget; \$74,961 year to date on a budget of \$91,500. With 13 weeks left in the year we expect to hit, or exceed, that budget number. Our total budgeted expenses for 2023 are \$92,406. We have spent \$69,257, approximately 75% of the total budget.

Several months ago, we decided to open a money market account and a 9-month CD for the building fund. We deposited \$120k to the CD and \$5,333 to the money market. Since July we have earned \$901 in interest on the CD and \$52 on the money market.

The Finance Team met with the Leadership Team in September to discuss the 2024 budget. The budget was approved by the LT. It will be distributed to the congregation on October 22 to review in advance of the congregational meeting on November 5. Questions during that two-week review period should be directed to a member of the finance team; Tammy Fisher, Ruthie White, Wayne Grossnickle, Glenn Routzhan, or Kathy Fisher.

Kathy Fisher has decided to step down from the finance team in 2024. We will need a new member to join the team in early 2024.

Gifts and Discernment Team by Darlene Moser -

Virginia and I were informed a few months ago that there are going to be three replacements needed for positions on three different teams by this coming year, 2024. We have been praying for direction and have been declined by the ones we felt were good candidates, only to find out they felt their plates were already full or that they do not feel qualified for these particular positions. If there is someone reading this right now that is feeling that the Holy Spirit has been nudging them to get more involved in the work and growth of New Beginnings Church please make yourself known to either Pastor Karen, or Virginia Lewis, or Darlene Moser of the Gifts and Discernment Team. We would be glad to answer any questions you may have. We covet your prayers for the replacement of these important positions. God bless and direct our dear church with new workers for the glory of His Kingdom. We thank you all for your help.

Information Technology by Eddie Moser: The setup team members have been trained on the setup and reset of the sound board as well as the setup of the church facility for worship service. Along with the setup responsibilities, they also have to put the sound board and facility back to the status they were found. There is a checklist in the back of the red binder in the pew near the sound board we are using to assure we don't miss anything during setup and reset.

Children's Church by Wendy Drum: God's children gathered the last few months, singing, praying, coloring, crafting and most of all learning about our God. We have journeyed through the book of Genesis, the Beginning, Noah, the tall Tower of Babble,

Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, how Joseph saves his family and more. We now embark into adventures through Exodus and learning about the Wordless Book, and the most important book of their lives, the Bible. We are excited as we keep our eyes fixed on Jesus during this special time of year with Thanksgiving and celebrating the birth of our Saviour. Please pray for our children, those here and far to know him and grow personally in relationship with our Lord. We give thanks and glory for sending the children to learn, follow, and carry the light into the world. All children are welcome to join Sunday mornings during worship for more adventures through the Bible. At any time during the service the nursery to the rear of the sanctuary is available as needed for quiet space. It is equipped with a pew, a rocking chair, a window and a speaker so the message can be both seen and heard. During a designated time in the worship service, children are dismissed from the sanctuary with the teachers and invited to attend downstairs in the Sunday School room. Emergency & Safety Response Team by Jerry Fogle

After receiving valuable input from church leadership, the Emergency and Safety Response Team (ESRT) drafted a revision to the Emergency and Safety Action Plan (ESAP), Rev. 0, which covered use of facilities at the Amvets in Middletown and Burkittsville Ruritan in Burkittsville. Before the revision was finalized, New Beginnings (NBCBC) entered into a trial six-month lease at the Middletown Valley Seventh-Day Adventist Church. Since this was a new church facility to the congregation, a separate ESAP was drafted covering use of the SDA church. Both versions of the ESAP were approved by the Leadership Team in August 2023 and training on the documents was completed in September 2023. The ESRT will monitor the implementation of these plans and make any appropriate revisions when necessary. It is our goal to keep worship and other activities at NBCBC as safe as possible.


